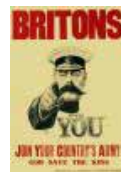

Our morning tour 9.30am to 1.30pm

We cover the three major battles that took place around Ypres and the Salient. It includes the major sites such as Essex Farm, a German cemetery, the first gas attack at Vancouver Corner, Tyne Cot cemetery at Passchendale, Polygon Wood and unique trenches at Hill 62. (Entrance 4e) This is a tour that appeals to all areas of interest and gives a comprehensive view of the suffering and tragedy that war brings.

Our afternoon tour 2.00pm to 5.30pm

The southern side of the Salient also saw enormous fighting in the battle of Messines, June 1917. This battle is particularly known for the use of mining tunnels under the German front line. We view the impressive Caterpillar Crater and Hill 60 where the closeness of the trenches defies imagination. Also included is the Irish Peace Park, the New Zealanders at Messines, and German trenches at Bayernwald finishing at the famous 1914 Xmas Truce.

An opportunity - departing from Ypres - to see the major sites on the Somme in one day. We include the Australians at Pozieres, Fricourt German cemetery, Lochnagar Crater, the Sunken Lane, New Foundland Park, the Ulster Tower and Lutyens impressive and dominating Thiepval Memorial. Plus other sites of interest. We always endeavour to make the tour fit the interest of those on board.

Our Vimy tour 8.30am to 5.30pm

This is a one day tour from Ypres which largely explores the Canadians heroic efforts in taking the Vimy Ridge in 1917. Also, an opportunity to walk in the Grange Tunnel, to visit the beautiful Cabaret Rouge cemetery where the Canadian unknown soldier was previously interred, French and German trenches, a German cemetery and the impressive French national cemetery at Notre Dame de Lorette.

Fromelles 9.30am to 1.30pm

We tour the battlefields of Fromelles and the first actions of the Australians on the Western Front on 19 – 20 July 1916. After a day and a nights fighting 1,500 British and 5,533 Australians were killed, wounded or taken prisoner. It was a decisive victory for the Germans without the Allies gaining any ground.
